We were working in MPDPIP a world bank aided project as Project Facilitation support Organization in 39 villages of Nowgong block in district Chhatarpur, Madhya Pradesh from 2001 to 2008 formed 1000 common interest group a group around 32 type activities mostly land based activities providing irrigation support with 432 community dug well and 57 stop dams to recharge ground water aquifers across Bhadar River, benefiting 7000 household and 35000 people investing around 9 crore amount.

Present Activities: To sustain these common interest group we have a Nowgong Agriculture Producer company having 1300 shareholders having 32 lakh capital to start had done business of 90 lakh to sale agri-input to our shareholders and others farmers of the block.

Agriculture Diversification: To diversify agriculture we have community managed community nursery we have sale 375 Disha chille variety to 2500 farmers has done business of 2 lakh producing 150 quintal in one acres of land with 43 thousand net profit to these 2500 farming household.

The organization was involved in Swajal project from 1998 in 24 villages of Jhansi and Lalitpur district of Uttar Pradesh constructed 4 piped water supply scheme in village Chirkana, Rajgir of Bangra block, Jhansi & Churavani, Budavani of Talbehat block of district Lalitpur, in village Kagar, Saivara, Daily and Jarbo first time introduced Mini Water Supply scheme benefiting 4 hours time saving for the women .

Also install 177 hand pumps in 21 villages of district Jhansi & Lalitpur, in sanitation programme we have constructed 1000 individual twin pit pour flush toilet in 24 villages in association with village water & sanitation committees. involved in 24 villages in district Jhansi and Lalitpur from 1998 to 2002 with amount of Rs. 1 crore 20 lakh
